# MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS December 5, 2012

The open meeting was called to order by the President at 7:35pm and minutes of the November 2012 meeting were read and approved.

#### **President's Report**

- Jim Litzinger stated that 10N will be sectioned off to create a meeting room and storage sections for LBJC, CSULB crew and LBRA. Jim will go over plans for the project with Mark Sandoval and submit them to the city with costs sent to the appropriate City business manager. An internal load-bearing wall will be removed and Sandoval stated that the engineering costs fall on LBRA.
- Xmas regatta worked out well with all shirts sold, only a few bits of bad weather and a record number of entries. Jim and Renn will hold a wrap up meeting.
- The president turned the floor over to the Jill Gresham of the fundraising committee to report on plans for an event proposed for May to be held at The Wine Crush wine bar. The committee intends to hold a silent auction and requested the board's permission from the board to send out an appeal to the membership for items for the auction (approved by consensus).
- With respect to the dock rebuild, John Nunn has tried to contact Mark Lopez of the City on engineering and design. URS (Tonu Mets' company) will likely to do engineering; however they cannot commence work without approval from the City. Dredging issues may cause some delays; however, there does not seem to be a deadline for spending the allocated funds. Pat Hayes asked whether the new dock might be designed to accommodate more boats, and Sandoval stated that changes to the footprint would have to go through the Costal Commission, which may be a worth trying.

#### Treasurer's Report

- With respect to the 2011 tax returns, Andrea Arriola stated that she needed an inventory specifically to
  determine if there are JL goods or Spring Regatta t-shorts remaining. Two athlete applications for
  training support have been received (see written applications and proposals in the permanent
  records).
- Under receivables, \$3210 is owed from SDRC. LBJC has some amount due but has time, as does Powerhouse fitness. Thus far from the Xmas Regatta, \$16K in regatta entry fees and \$4K in t-shirts sales are on the books, with approximately another \$5K for outstanding regatta entry fees to come.
- Guillermo Ordenes created an interactive map of the Bay Series course that uses Google Earth. Andrea will post it on the website.
- Andrea needs an updated roster for USRowing data requests and fees. Both she and Jim will contact the old membership chair to obtain the current list.

### Captain's Report

• The Captain reported that he commenced a thorough clean up starting at the dock, moving through the enclosure then into the bays, (with Bill Chinn helping in bays.) and now is onto 10N. When questioned whether a work party might not help with this cleaning, AC stated that he does not want to

- have equipment, parts and tools moved to where he can no longer locate them after the cleaning process. Therefore work parties should be organized with that in mind (say painting walls rather than consolidating spare parts), and held away from regatta or travel dates.
- With respect to equipment replacement, the recently repaired V2 will still be rowable for novice rowers for another couple years. AC stated that the US national team has several used Empacher doubles, pairs and quads for sale that otherwise will be sent back to Europe at the end of the month. A quad and pair/doubles in the lightweight/midweight range are available for \$9K to \$15K. The board asked AC to make recommendations as to what to buy and asked Andrea to determine how much the club can prudently spend.
- AC stated that the club's weight bars must be replaced with modern bars with ball bearings; new York bars are about \$230-270. The Captain will look scout out various local vendors and report back in a couple weeks.
- Richard Dudash cleaned all the windows in the club last week. Many thanks to him!

#### **Old Business**

The action items list was reviewed, during which Keith Johnson agreed that LBJC will pay another third of the maintenance fee during the summer months. Pat Hayes asked Andrea Arriola to issue an invoice for the extra one third maintenance fee for two months in the summer of 2012. Johnson suggested that the LBJC treasurer and Andrea work together on the invoice. In the matter of the possible misconduct of an LBJC coach, the three LBJC board members present stated that without a police report number and officer's badge number they could find no more information. [LBJC had sent email acknowledgement of receipt of the letter reporting the possible misconduct; a hard copy is appended in the permanent records.]

## **New Business**

- Jack Nunn is closing the Powerhouse Fitness warehouse location and has rack weights, 10 ergs, and ski ergs to sell. AC knows of a CrossFit group that's seeking equipment and will put Jack in contact with them.
- Jim Litzinger reported that two entries were put in at the Xmas Regatta for unaffiliated, under 18 junior
  girls who were not LBRA members yet used LBRA boats. After discussion the board concluded that
  the facts must be determined and the membership rules must be enforced by the board. [These
  rowers should fill out the paperwork, pay the fees and then they can come before the board for
  approval, per procedures approved in March 2012] Jim will ask Dan McGill to produce their paperwork
  and checks.
- Jim asked Vaughn Sherman whether he had sent emails to the Long Beach school board concerning an LBJC coach. Keith Johnson accused Vaughn of sending a similar communication to letter Dr. Sandy Blazer and demanded to know his sources. Vaughn acknowledged that he had informed Sandy Blazer of a questionable situation at LBJC that should be investigated. Keith Johnson asked that Vaughn and Patty Sherman not be allowed in the boathouse. After considerable heated discussion the issue was tabled.
- Pat Hayes noted that the floor coating on men's locker room is disintegrating. Jim said this is high on the list of repairs; Renn Levy has experience with industrial floor coatings and will help.
- Andrea Arriola motioned to adjourn, Jill Gresham seconded. Before voting to adjourn, the board agreed to move the January 2013 meeting to the 9<sup>th</sup>. The meeting adjourned at 9:39.
