

Physical Distance Protocols for
Long Beach Rowing Association – Stage 2
Bay Access for 1x (Private & Club)

Restrictions on equipment

1. Equipment usage is limited to rowing only in singles.
2. Reservations must be made on iCrew, ahead of time. No less than 15 minutes apart for club boats. No rowing of club or private boats when attendants are not on duty.
3. Individuals should always maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet.
4. Masks are to be worn in and around the boathouse vicinity, the wash deck and the dock.
5. Masks can be removed once on the water, and to be put back on prior to returning to the dock.
6. Private boats will be moved by attendants back to their previous location inside the bay or the shed.
7. Members must bring their own towels for cleaning of boats, even club boats.
8. Members must carry their own hand sanitizer.
9. Hand sanitizer, soap, bucket and sponge is made available for ready access, next to the 3 water spigots on the building and near the enclosure.
10. Private boats – As usual, it is the owner's responsibility to clean and dry their boat and oars.
11. Club Singles – As usual, user is responsible to clean boats and oars. All members must be able to launch and return the boat without assistance. Boat will be cleaned with soap and water and disinfected as supervised by the attendants.

General Facility restrictions

12. Attendants are the only ones allowed to enter the bays and enclosure. No member is allowed in the boathouse, unless working as the on duty attendant. All rooms other than the boat bays, are to remain locked and inaccessible.
13. Attendant(s) will carry the private and club boats along with the oars, to the wash deck and return it, once rowing and sanitation is completed.
14. Erg and weight room will remain closed. There will be no member access, not even to bring ergs outside.
15. All restrooms are closed.
16. The Boat Captain tool room is locked and no members, except Boat Captain are allowed in.
17. Members will only be able to row at times when attendants are working. Only the Boat Captain or Manager will be able to access facilities at any other times.
16. This protocol will be posted in multiple locations, visible to all members, attendants and the public.
17. Members must electronically sign these protocols on iCrew to be allowed to row. Members who do not abide will be removed from access.
18. Trash cans are no-touch.
19. Members are to only row and leave. Do not hang out! No congregation or socializing allowed, even on Boathouse Lane.
20. Benches are not available for use.
21. Any individual known to have been exposed to a person who has been sick or diagnosed with Covid-19 must self report to Charles Griffin, President, if the rower was physically present at LBRA within the prior 14 days, and the individual must self quarantine for 14 days before returning.

Remember we're all in this together and we just need to help each other out!

ATTENDANT'S JOB DESCRIPTION

1. All attendants and members must use cloth face coverings at all times.
2. Bring reserved oars and boats out for members, from inside the bays to the wash deck.
3. All boats need to be carried by attendant(s) to the wash deck and returned to original location by attendants..
4. Bring rolling rack outside, and back inside, when everyone is done rowing.
5. Spray Covid-19 approved sanitizer on hose spigots, slings, bucket handles and other high touch areas after each use.
6. Make sure there's soap, buckets and sanitizer available by all three water spigots on the wash deck.
7. Spray club singles with sanitizer on oarlocks, seat/foot stretcher area, oar handles and other high touch areas after boat and oars have been washed and dried.
8. For private boats, sanitize hands after boat or oars are carried.
9. Open up all bay and enclosure doors and close at the end of boathouse hours.
10. Attendants will enforce rules and inform the board of infractions.
